MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN






STUDENT INTERACTION PROGRAM WITH THE CONSUL GENERAL

The whole workshop was very enlighting and increased the knowledge of the undersigned immensely. We would like to thank the management in allowing us to attend the workshop.






