FACULTY FEEDBACK ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2014-15

Based on the curriculum evaluation by teachers the following actions were taken.

- 1. More than 70 % of the teachers are under the opinion that the syllabus is suitable to the course and agreed with the opinion that the syllabus is need based. It is recommended to the board of studies members to make the necessary changes in the syllabi.
- 2. 75 % of teachers were agreed that the syllabi are well defined and clear to teachers and students, and the course content is followed by corresponding reference material.
- 3. Less than 20% of the teachers have the opinion that sufficient numbers of prescribed books were not available in the library. The committee had decided to generate enough fund for purchasing more books to the library.
- 4. It was decided to set up department library for each department in addition to the central library. Majority have the opinion that the books listed as reference materials were relevant updated and appropriate.
- 5. All most all the teachers have the opinion that the course/syllabus has good balance between theory and application. Majority of the teachers have the opinion that course/syllabus has made interested in the subject area.
- 6. More than 90% of the teachers are agreeing that the books prescribed/listed as reference materials were relevant, updated and appropriate.
- 7. Majority of the faculties from various streams could not able to cover the syllabi properly in time since the number of working days for one semester is less. It is recommended to the board of studies to modify the syllabus according to the present scenario.
- 8. Faculties have no freedom to propose, modify or suggest new topics in the syllabus. But they give their suggestions to the board of studies members during the syllabus revision time.
- 9. The university is giving provision to the faculties to attend refresher courses, orientation programmes and they can join in faculty improvement programmes. As per the university regulations every teacher has to attend certain number of refresher and orientation programmes.
